Approval of the Minutes from October 13, 2016

Copies of the Minutes of the October 13, 2016 Economic Development meeting were distributed to the members for their review. Alderman Krueger made a motion to approve the minutes as submitted. Mr. Taylor seconded the motion, and it was unanimously approved.

Retaining Businesses in Sunset Hills

Alderman Baebler stated that Ms. Schiavo did some research and found that another municipality is working with the South County Times (newspaper) using an insert in the paper. This insert is published approximately 5 times a year and lists the businesses in the community. She feels this would be a good tool for the City of Sunset Hills to use in promoting their businesses.


Economic Development –Eric Sterman, City Administrator
