Department Status Report

Project Update:

Driving range –We have reached \$100,000 in gross revenue.

Shared Use/pedestrian trail – As you know Kirkwood, Fenton and us applied for a grant to assist with trail connection from proposed bridge to existing trail system. We held our 1st TAC meeting on July 15th to discuss schedule, media relations and review original concept plans and potential issues. 1st Public meeting/open house format was held and we had 357 surveys turned in and 187 people attend the meeting. The 2nd Public meeting was held on October 15th at 6pm at Riverchase; public feedback forms are available until October 25th. The conceptual plan proposal will be brought to you this month for approval/questions, etc.. Preliminary plans have been approved with scenic overlook being removed and no river access. Intitution and Logic has started Final design for the project.

Park Rules – working on updating Park Ordinance Rules & Regulations, anticipate to have for your review next month.

Park Update

Gempp –All Tree identification signage for 26 trees are completed. Signs are installed and Trails are now open to the public.

Watson Trail Park – Tennis Courts, Trails, Disc Golf, shelters, restrooms, Playgrounds and Fishing Access are now open to the public.

Innie Ha Ha Park – Trails, shelter, restrooms, Playgrounds and soccer fields are now open to the public
