**Honeysuckle Removal**

Ms. Yeggee and Ms. McGrane suggested using the company they use; they have under contract and have had huge success with. Their recommendation was to work with contractor and either basal treat and/or foliage spray the entire park. Mr. Brown reported that he will start to make contacts and check availability of the contractor.

### **Community Involvement Day**

Mr. Brown reported that he would like to advertise and offer a honeysuckle removal day for the community. He has selected April 23<sup>rd</sup>, one week after Earth Day Celebration. Time 10am – 12:30, serve hot dogs, chips, drink after the event at the Gazebo for all that help with the event.

Ms. Hoffmann made a motion to utilize contractor to remove invasive from the park and to promote community involvement day. Ms. Lages seconded. Motion was unanimously approved.

Mr. Koeger requested that a 6' buffer be created between property and fence along the Wembley woods side of the area. Mr. Brown reported that he will evaluate and have the staff start the process when time is available.

Mr. Pyne asked when the Johnny on the spot would be delivered. Mr. Brown reported that it would be on the property by April 1<sup>st</sup>.
