APPROVAL OF THE MINUTES

Copies of the Minutes of the February 16, 2016 meeting were distributed to the members for their review. Jan Hoffmann made a motion to approve the Minutes as amended. Jim Koeger seconded the motion, and it was unanimously approved.

OLD BUSINESS

Eagle Scout Project (Sun Dial) – Mr. Black made a presentation for the Sun Dial; which he presented a couple of years ago. He proposed concrete structure 21/2' tall, with steel/metal on top with sun dial measurements. The location that was selected was adjacent to gazebo area.

NEW BUSINESS

Walk through of the Property

Items identified for Mr. Brown and staff to maintain:

1. Parking lot branches overhanging bus area
2. Remove brush piles from community involvement weekend last weekend.
3. Remove Ash Tree at front entrance sign
4. Plant native species at front entrance sign
5. Move kiosk area to other side of the parking lot
6. Clean up around opening tree (Bur Oak) located near shed.

7. Tree branches over hanging trail near butterfly garden area
8. Remove maple tree from wetland area
9. Order Monarch Waystation Sign
10. Bench in prairie area – need to re-set – the bench is too low to ground.
11. Install mulch ring around fence area where native plants can be seen easier to identify for patrons.

Community Involvement Day

Mr. Brown reported that we had 13 people attend the event – they concentrated on (2) areas and did a great job. The remaining other portion of the park was treated by Native Landscapes Solutions for invasive plants.

Discussion of additional signage

Mr. Brown reported that we have not replaced:

- Vine signage
- Wetland (2) area
- Visions of times past
- Maple Grove Area

Discussion of new signage – The Commission agreed to replace Vine and wetland. Maple grove area signage will be when to use a maple and when not to have a Maple tree in the area. Visions of time past will include history as well as plans for the future in the area.
