MINUTES

The minutes of the Police Advisory Board meeting of April 12, 2016 were reviewed. A motion to approve the minutes as distributed was made by Mr. Althoff and seconded by Mr. Epperson. The motion passed unanimously.

COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT

Chief LaGrand updated the Board regarding the establishment of the Office of Community Outreach and Engagement. This function will be staffed by Sgt. Hagen. The duties will generally include various types of community outreach as well as the establishment of a presence on various social media platforms. Chief LaGrand will keep the Board updated on the status of this office.

OFFICER SAFETY

Chief LaGrand made a brief presentation about a ballistic vest that is effective against high velocity rifle rounds such as a .338 Lapua Magnum sniper round. There was a discussion of possibly purchasing one vest for each marked police vehicle at a cost of about \$300 per unit. Chief LaGrand will continue the investigation into this type of vest.

OTHER MATTERS

There was a discussion of the situation at the Econolodge. Chief LaGrand updated the Board on current efforts by the city to resolve some of the issues.

ADJOURNMENT

A motion to adjourn was made by Mr. Epperson and seconded by Mr. Schillinger. The motion passed unanimously. The meeting adjourned at 7:40 PM.
