Update on Survey Results:

Discuss Art Structure on Loan:

Ms. Turkovic presented an art structure that she proposes to place on loan to the city; the committee liked the idea. Location was discussed, Mr. Brown had sent (3) locations in Watson Trail Park – the committee will review one more time and make final decision at February meeting.

Mr. Brown presented 51 sculptures from Call to Artist through sculptures on the move program with CCA. The committee reviewed and discussed and selected their top (9) that will be submitted at next CCA meeting (February 26th).

Proposed Art Fair

Mr. Brown presented the proposed date of October, 2019; give the committee plenty of time to organize and run. Dates to remember – September 21, October 5 and October 19 – huge events planned already for 2019. The committee selected April 27th, 2019.

Signage Update

Mr. Brown stated that he has ordered the sign holder (6) of them; sign is still being worked on – hope to have something soon from designer.
