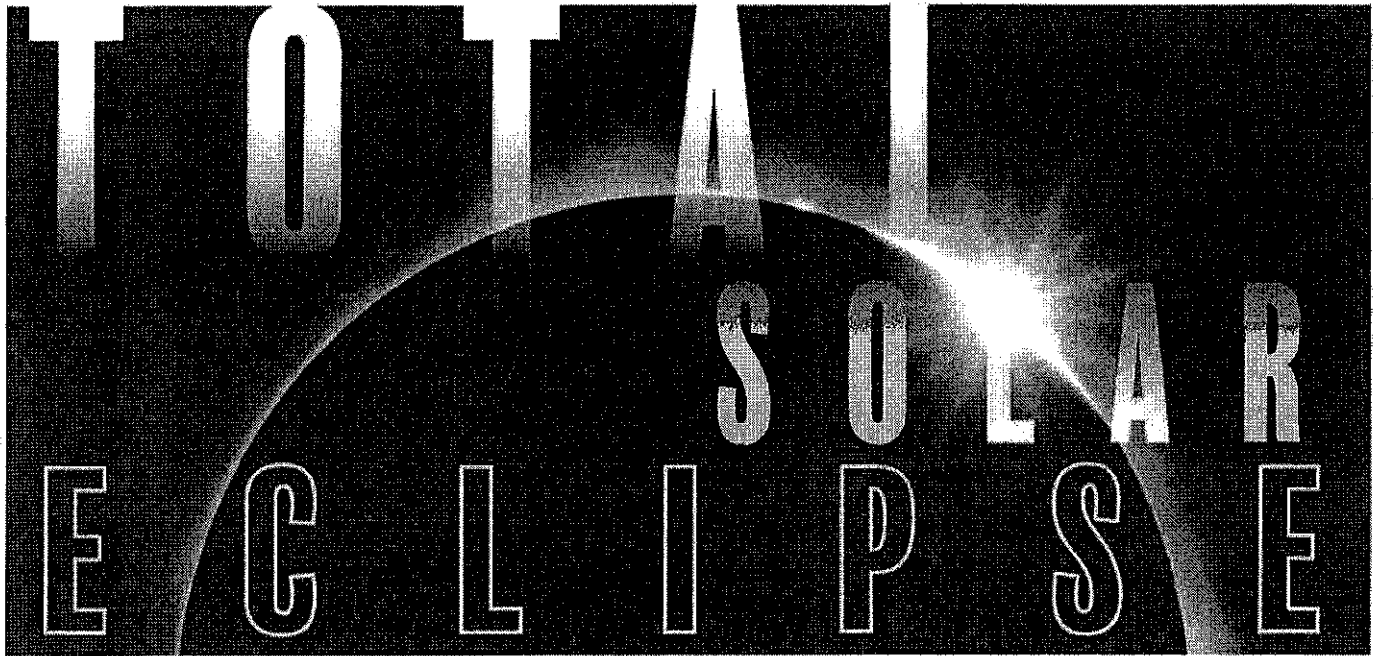
The Parks & Recreation Commission next meeting will be March 22, 2017.

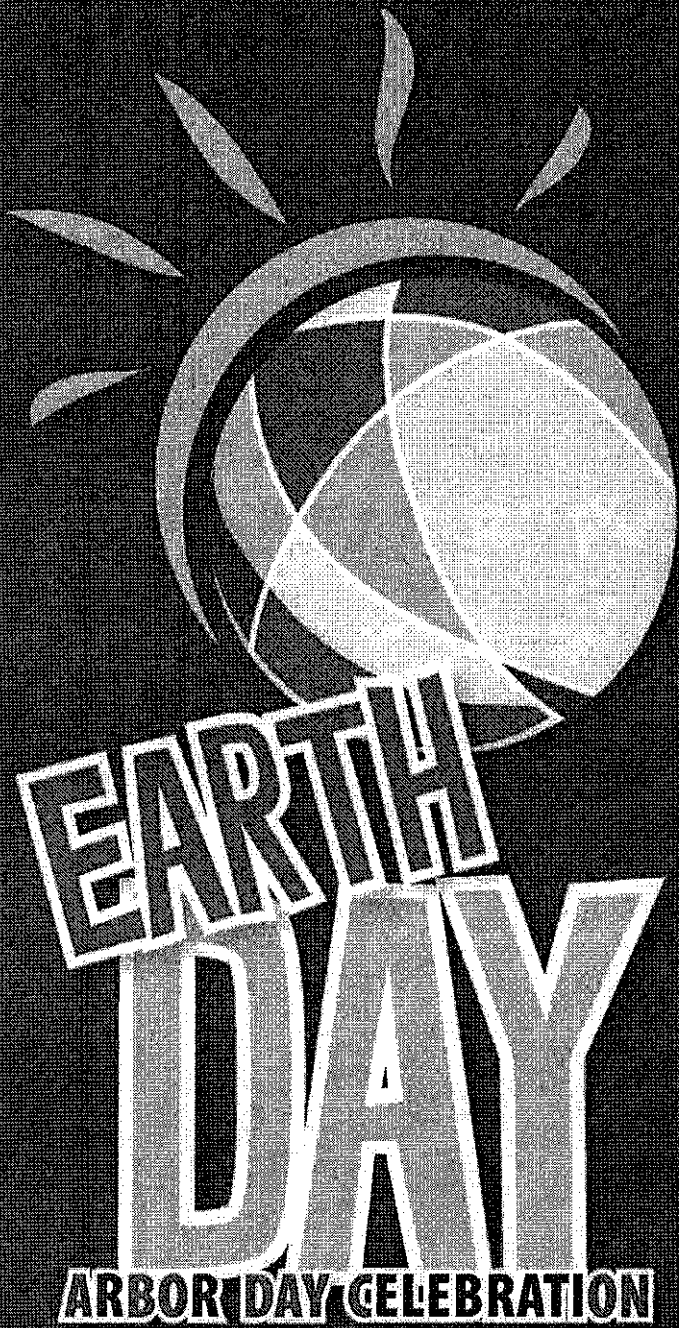
