New Business

- A. **Introductions** – Mr. Brown introduced himself and then let everyone on the new committee introduce themselves. Mr. Brown asked if anyone would like to be the chair of the committee moving forward. Mr. McGuire was nominated and approved by Committee.
- B. **Review of Proposed Objectives/goals** - Mr. Brown passed out draft/proposed objectives/goals for the committee. The committee looked over the document and agreed to review and approve at next meeting; overall everyone thought it was a good starting point for the committee.
- C. **Brainstorming** – Mr. Brown mentioned the following items that has been brought to his attention:
 - Sculptures

 - Creative Alliance

The Committee discussed all of these areas broadly but thought the first priority for the committee should be the cloverleaf at Watson/Lindbergh. How do we include granite signage/landscaping/sculptures into our main entrance of the city? The committee discussed the following for signage (designs – maybe look at several different designs before moving forward, add neon to sign (Route 66), place (1) large stone at base and build sign from that, city wide contest, create a ruins area within cloverleaf, stain bridge the color of old bridge).

The Committee liked the Pianos on Parade idea and thought it was a great idea to start bringing art into one of the parks. They agreed to spend the \$1,500 to bring this program into Watson Trail Park this year if possible.
