APPROVAL OF THE MINUTES

Copies of the Minutes of the January 24, 2018 Parks & Recreation Commission meeting were distributed to the members for their review. Ms. Yarasheski made a motion to accept the minutes as submitted. Ms. Livingston seconded the motion, and it was unanimously approved.

OLD BUSINESS

- A. Board of Alderman Report Mr. Bershe stated that at the Board of Alderman, approval for the donated playground was approved.
- B. Pool Advisory Mr. Brown reported on approved landscaping plan, between Lazy River and Comp Pool, Update on sand filters, handrails and painting projects and gave a brief report on pre-sale event sold \$40,000 worth of pool memberships.
- C. Gempp Committee The remaining two signs have been approved, hope to have installed by end of April. Mr. Brown reported that we are acquiring bids to remove honeysuckle in the area.

- D. Urban Forestry Commission Mr. Brown reported that Board of Alderman approved moving the responsibilities of the Urban Forestry Commission under the direction of the Park Board, adding (2) additional people to the commission. Welcome Pat Otto and Claudia Svoboda to the Park Board.
- E. Swim & Dive Advisory Mr. Brown reported that we have a new president of the swim and Dive committee, Carrie Clay coming on board.
- F. Fitness Committee Nothing to report
- G. Art Committee Mr. McGuire reported on:
 - -Proposed Art Fair April 27th, 2019
 - -Sculptures on the move looking at installing (1) piece on April 11th

Director's Report:

- Proposed Playground update Mr. Brown reported on funds being donated to create a playground near athletic complex, Mr. Brown has been working with potential donor to create/solidify exactly what donor is looking for – including trails, playground equipment, benches, etc. Board of Alderman approved last night.
- Municipal Parks Grant Application Mr. Brown reported that the grant was selected for funding \$352,000 for the purchase, construction of three restrooms Minnie, Nancy Eschbach and Kitun Park. Minnie we are looking at vaulted restrooms, Nancy Eschbach ties to sewer district and Kitun we are still looking into meeting with MSD to discuss options.
- 3. SunCrest Fest September 22, 2018 location Truman School, road from Kitun to Robyn. Sponsorship letters went out last week.
- 4. Bike Cruise September 21st 10pm -12am, working with Mayor to host 1st annual bike cruise along route 66, Mr. Brown will be presenting to Mayors from other municipalities with next couple of weeks.
- 5. MO DOT/GRG Shared Use Bridge/Trail Mr. Brown reported that he submitted grant request for close to 1 million for the construction of touchdowns on both sides of the river, restrooms, parking, and other site amenities. Mr. Brown will be presenting project to Municipal League on April 9th.
- Flagpole Project -Mr. Brown reported that a donor has made a contribution in honor of Joyce Franklin to add (2) additional flagpoles and landscaping for the area in front of City Hall
- 7. HWY 270/30 Mr. Brown reported that they will be assisting Alderman Lipe with a tree planting project along HWY 270/30. WE will be planting approximately 70- trees to improve the site line.
- Working with GRG to plant 75 native trees along Rock Alva shared trail, planting on April 19th.
