T- shirts – logo/bright for volunteers/staff; have an artist making shirts on hand (designs)

Mr. Jordan presented an idea, creating a roundtable of different individuals the day of the art fair to create an art project as a group (using different ages, etc.). The group would be on site and create the art project as a group during the art fair.

Ms. Huitt is reaching out to Park Staff to walk the park and identify location of vendors for the Fair within the next (3) weeks.

Tattoo/Scavenger hunt – create stamps at each booth to have individuals move to all booths – turn in at the end – have a small prize for turning in and then have (3) prizes for winners – drawing.

The Commission was thrilled with the energy and the direction the art fair is shaping up to be.
