**APPROVAL OF THE MINUTES**

Copies of the Minutes of the May 22, 2019 Parks & Recreation Commission/Pool Advisory meeting were distributed to the members for their review. Ms. Monda made a motion to accept the minutes as submitted. Ms. Duke seconded the motion, and it was unanimously approved.

**OLD BUSINESS**

Board of Alderman – nothing to report

Swim & Dive Team – Mr. Brown stated that the swim and dive team have teamed up with the Foundation on a mouse race fundraiser on June 22 to help assist with additional costs.

Directors Report – Mr. Brown gave a brief update on new HVAC system for concession area and office area, purchase of new tubes and the purchase of a new BB hoop.

**New Business**

**A. Aquatic Facility Update –**

Mr. Brown provided a two week look at where we are at this time June 10<sup>th</sup>, currently we are down approximately \$20,000 from last year, largely based on daily visits (the weather has not be great for swimming yet), concession down about \$2,000, based on volume, membership down about \$9,000. Mr. Brown explained that he is not worried yet, let's see how we look at July meeting.

**Other Matters deemed Necessary**

Ms. Hoffmann asked about:

- clock for the lazy river, Mr. Watts stated that he will have one up ASAP.
- Lap swimming update, Mr. Watts reported that it has started off slow based on the weather
- Restroom – Are the lifeguards still checking after each shift? Mr. Nate stated that they are checked about every 30/45 minutes, Mr. Watts stated that he would address with staff.
- Sign – no playing in showers, Mr. Brown stated that he would get a sign for the showers in women’s restroom
- Water Aerobics update – Mr. Watts reported that we have classes everyday with two instructors, one more intensive than the other.

Ms. Monda asked if we could place more curtains under the sink in restrooms, she volunteered to do herself. Mr. Brown stated that if she wanted to purchase and sew that we would reimburse for her time and material. Ms. Monda agreed.
