DISCUSSION OF POTENTIAL CRESTWOOD-SUNSET HILLS 2020 POOL PARTNERSHIP

Mayor Fribis gave a brief background on the state's guidelines on opening the pool and the decision not to open the city's pool.

Mayor Fribis contacted Crestwood's mayor to see if we could do a joint venture between our residents using their pool. The City of Sunset Hills will allocate \$10,000 to subsidize the difference of the pool passes, resident vs. non-resident rate.

Mr. Brown sent a survey out to 147 members and 47% of the residents stated they would take advantage of this subsidizing.

Mr. Sterman stated that this \$10,000 is not to be exceeded. He stated some residents have already paid the Lindbergh rate and asked if we should reimburse the difference.

Alderman McMunn asked what the Lindbergh rate is. Mr. Brown stated \$350.00 family pass and \$140.00 adult pass.

Alderman Wong made a motion to accept this proposal, Alderman Bersche seconded it. Alderman Krueger made a motion to amend the proposal to subsidize any previously purchased passes.

Mayor Fribis did a voice vote and it was unanimously approved.

Alderman McMunn made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Alderman Wong seconded the motion and the meeting adjourned at 10:16 a.m.
