MINUTES

A motion was made to approve the minutes of the October 16, 2018 meeting by Mr. Schillinger and it was seconded by Mr. Finney. The motion passed unanimously.

Chief Dodge provided a synopsis of recent residential burglaries and said the investigations are ongoing.

Sgt. Hagen provided an update regarding Community Outreach endeavors which included continued Active Shooter preparedness with local schools and pre-schools and working with local churches and schools to establish their emergency response plans. The police department was one of 26 municipal police departments that sponsored the Risky Behavior Program for the public which was an excellent program and had a very good turnout. Patrol cars were restocked with baseball cards in April and they are being handed out kids in the community.

Sgt. Hagen completed the Meramec Valley Citizens Corps' Community Emergency Response Team (CERT) course and is working with the Crestwood CERT group to establish a program for the City of Sunset Hills.

Cops and Bobbers was held June 1, 2019; 43 kids registered for the event and 24 attended.

Two officers, Cpl. Kim Lane and Sgt. Robbie Hagen, will be participating in the Girl Scouts of Eastern MO's Camp Fury the last week of June. The camp was designed and is administered by female fire fighters and female police officers for girls 7th through 12th grade.

Sgt. Hagen has made arrangements to bring bleeding emergency training offered by Stop the Bleed STL to all the police officers, and will become an instructor with the program. The program will be offered to the public in the future.

Sgt. Hagen added that a section of the department's social media policy was amended to bring the department into compliance with the most recent court rulings regarding the use of social media platforms by government entities.

Ms Snyder made a motion to adjourn the meeting which was seconded by Mr. Schillinger. The motion passed unanimously and the meeting adjourned at 6:45 PM.
