1. Municipal Parks Grant Application – Mr. Brown reported that the restroom grant was approved by MSD, we went out for bid, working with lowest best contractor and waiting for approval from MDC.

3. Bank Stabilization – survey has been concluded along the bank of Minnie Ha Ha Park –being reviewed by COE and MSD.
