3. General discussion

Mr. Baker opened the meeting and spoke of the general items of a typical Public Works Committee meeting.

Alderman Price asked who initiates requests of the Public Works Committee. Mr. Baker responded that they typically come in from residents.

Mr. Searcy detailed that many times matters come as a phone call to staff and they recommend the reside write a letter, send it to City Hall as a formal request for consideration at the Public Works Committee level. He went on to suggest a couple of general items the Committee could routinely discuss such as complaint matters and zoning request updates.

Alderman Price brought up the issue of the intersection of Highway 30 and West Watson. He stated he felt this was a dangerous intersection. The Committee discussed several alternatives to this area including a right-in right-out configuration at Highway 30 and chopping off West Watson as a connector route at various points. They covered details like road jurisdictions as well as pluses and minuses of these differing road configuration scenarios.

Court Administrator Lay joined the meeting and informed the group that Municipal Court was under delay until this meeting concluded.

Chairman Lipe brought up that the new solar lights are well received and would like to see more of them implemented in the City streetlight network.
