



As we work through this pandemic we are following closely the lead of St. Louis County. We are still on the stay at home order but Dr. Sam Page is reducing public health restrictions on May 18, 2020. Sunset Hills will have all employees return to work at City Hall with safety guidelines. Doors will be unlocked into the lobby, but doors leading into Administrative Offices and Public Works offices will be locked. Please call ahead, if possible, to make an appointment. The hours will be 8:00am to 4:30pm. Fines and tickets can be paid at the inside lobby window.

The Parks Department has opened Kitun Dog Park and the tennis courts in Watson Trail Park as of May 8, 2020. Please check the website for details. The drinking fountain at Kitun Dog Park is off, so please plan accordingly. All the parks bathrooms are still closed and drinking fountains are off.

The following will remain closed: all entertainment, sporting events, conferences, playgrounds, swimming pools, gyms, and banquet facilities.

Public gatherings will be limited to 10 or fewer people.

Anyone not wearing a mask can be denied entry.

Businesses must have no more than 25% capacity, maintain or build social distancing procedures, provide a touch-less payment process, and have a daily disinfectant procedure. No containers can be brought into any business. Masks are required.

Concerned citizens should remain at home, especially senior citizens, or those with pre-existing conditions.

Thank you to all Sunset Hill residents and businesses that are following the rules and keeping us all safe. If one is affected, we are all affected. See the St. Louis County website for more information and details.

We have had nine cases of Covid-19 in Sunset Hills. All are recovering or have recovered. We have had no deaths. There have been no cases in our senior living facilities or nursing homes. Please stay safe and healthy.
